Mare, Gelding, Stallion, Colt or Filly any age.

#### Class 3 – In Hand M&M Small & Large (Excluding Welsh)

#### Class 14 – In Hand Horse/Pony with a Blemish or Acquired Mark.

Mare, Gelding, Stallion, Colt or Filly any age.

#### Class 15 – In Hand Young Handler

Mare or gelding, 4yrs old & over, not to exceed 148cm. Handler not to have attained their 13th Birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Open to Novice Horses/Ponies who have not previously won a showing class at BLF Show in the 2018 seasons.

#### Class 18 – Ridden New Combination (in the current year )

Mare or gelding, any height 4yr old & over.

#### Class 19 – Ridden Coloured, Spotted, Palomino & Dun – Plaited, Hogged, Traditional & Native

Mare or gelding any height 4yr old & over.

#### Class 20 – Ridden Mare & Gelding

Any Breed, type or height 4yr old & over.

If three or more of each type are presented then the class will be split for mares and

#### geldings. Points will be awarded down the line for each section.

#### Class 21 – Ridden Open Showing – Plaited

Mare or gelding any height 4yr old & over.

#### Class 22 – Ridden Hunter Horse

Mare or gelding 4yr old & over, to be over 14.2hds.

#### Class 23 – Ridden Hunter Pony

Mare or gelding 4yr old & over, to be 14.2hds and under

Mare or gelding any height 15yr old & over.

Plaited Ponies not to exceed 122cms & Rider not to have attained their 8th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

M&M Ponies not to exceed 128cms & Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Mare or Gelding 4yr old & Over.

Plaited Ponies not to exceed 122cms & Rider not to have attained their 8th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not to exceed 14.2hds. Max Height 1ft.

Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday as of the 1st January in the current year.

#### Class 42 – Open Pony Style & Performance Working Hunter NEW

Open Riders Age Class - Open to Seniors and Juniors Max height 2ft.

Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 14.2hds

No flat show required, this class is judged purely on style and performance during the jumping round and working hunter penalties apply. Each jumping effort is marked out of 10 points, plus an overall mark out of 10 for general style and performance. Open to Juniors & Seniors riding ponies. Pony/Rider combination must be suitable and safe (judge's discretion applies).

#### Class 43 – Senior Style & Performance Working Hunter NEW

Open Riders Age Class- Open to Seniors and Juniors Max height 2ft.

Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 14.2hds.

No flat show required, this class is judged purely on style and performance during the jumping round and working hunter penalties apply. Each jumping effort is marked out of 10 points, plus an overall mark out of 10 for general style and performance. Open to Juniors & Seniors riding horses. Horse/ Rider combination must be suitable and safe (judge's discretion applies).

#### Class 44 – Junior Novice Working Hunter

Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 14.2hds. Max height 2ft 6ins.

Rider not to have attained their 17th Birthday as of the 1st January in the current year.

#### Class 45 – Open Mountain & Moorland Working Hunter (Including Welsh & Shetlands)

Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over,

Max height 2.6ft, height of fences may differ if it is a qualifying class.

#### Class 46 – Senior Novice Working Hunter

Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 14.2hds. Max height 2ft 6ins.

Riders to have attained their 17th Birthday before 1st Jan as of current year.

Fences will not exceed 95cms in the first round.

Fences will not exceed 110cms in the first round.

Rider not to have attained their 17th Birthday as of the 1st January in the current year.

Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 14.2hds.

Fences will not exceed 65cms in the first round.

Rider to have attained their 17th Birthday as of the 1st January in the current year.

Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 14.2hds.

Fences will not exceed 75cms in the first round.

Fences will not exceed 95cms in the first round.
